## "You Are Now A \_\_\_\_\_"

Transform the AI into various roles or perspectives to tailor responses.

### EXAMPLES:

- "You are now a travel guide for Italy. Describe the best places to visit in Rome."
- "You are now a personal fitness coach. Create a 30-day workout plan for beginners."
- "You are now a historical expert on Ancient Egypt. Explain the significance of the pyramids."

## "How to Structure A Prompt"

Ensure clarity and detail in prompts to get the desired response.

### GUIDELINES:



#### Specify the Role:

Define the role or perspective for the AI.

**EXAMPLE:** "As a financial advisor, provide investment tips for beginners."



**Include Context:** Offer background information or context.

**EXAMPLE:** "Given the rise in remote work, suggest tools for improving team collaboration."



#### Define the Output Format:

Specify how the response should be structured.

**EXAMPLE:** "Create a list of five benefits of meditation, each with a brief explanation."

## "Writing Styles"

Explore different writing styles for various purposes.

### EXAMPLES:

#### PROFESSIONAL

"In today's business landscape, effective communication is paramount. Here are three strategies to enhance clarity in your emails."

#### CONVERSATIONAL

"Hey there! Let's chat about how to make your home cozier. Here are some tips to get you started."

#### PERSUASIVE

"Imagine a world where your energy bills are cut in half. Investing in solar panels can make this a reality."

## "How to Emulate A Writing Style"

Guide the AI to replicate specific writing styles or authors.

### GUIDELINES:

**Identify Key Elements:** Note the author's tone, vocabulary, and sentence structure.

#### EXAMPLE:

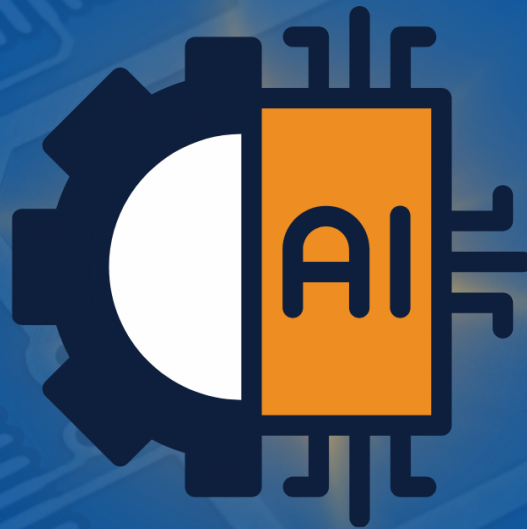
"Emulate the style of J.K. Rowling by using vivid descriptions and magical themes."
